**MORE GRAVE TRUTHS CEMETERY WALK**

*October 13, 2011, Hastings, MN* - Join the Dakota County Historical Society and Friends of LeDuc of Historic Hastings for what will be a truly unique event. Your tour will be led by the spirit Emma Leduc Claflin as she searches for her unmarked grave at Lakeside Cemetery. Her quest takes her to the graves of the William LeDuc family where she meets the ghost of her niece Florence LeDuc and others. Florence gives Emma a clue where to look for her "resting place". This all takes place on Saturday, October 15th when a strange phenomenon will cause a thinning of the veil between the "here" and "hereafter". In case of rain, the make-up date is Saturday, October 22, also beginning at 2 p.m. Tours start at the LeDuc Historic Estate, 1629 Vermillion Street, Hastings, MN 55033.

Voyeurs will meet other spirits stirring about that afternoon and evening including family members and friends of William and Mary Leduc (William, Mary, Florence, Alice, and Minnie Leduc; Vincent, Mabel, Edith, and Gus Gardner; Louisa Pringle, Carroll Simmons and Dr. Wisness.)

Tours run every hour starting at 2 p.m. with the final tour being 8:00 p.m. Special tour rates are \$5 per person. Transportation to and from the cemetery is provided.
