

Isaac B “Craig” Curry

Craig was born on September 8th, 1890 in Mattoon Illinois. He was born to parents Stephen Douglas Curry and Nancy Hart. After moving to Saint Paul he soon took up a job working at the Live Stock Exchange Office. While working at the Livestock Exchange his primary role was that of a clerk.

On June 5th, 1917 Craig registered for the draft at the age of 36 at the rank of sergeant. On September 3rd, 1918 he entered service for the United States army. He spent his time in the service working at the Office of Adjutant General. He was mustered out of service on December 20th, 2918.

After the war he started working as a government auditor in Washington DC. He married a woman named Viola Eggert Curry. On July 15th 1939 Craig passed away at Walter Reed hospital in Washington DC. He was laid to rest at Arlington National Cemetery and is located in section 18 grave 2287-A.
