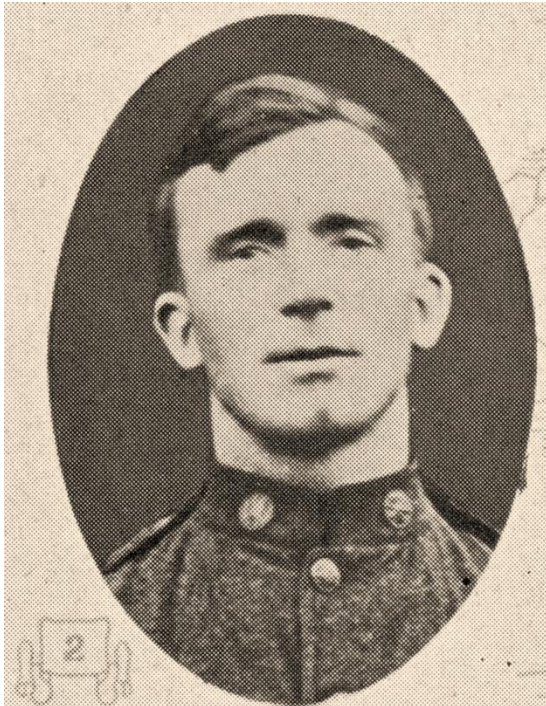


## Thomas James Gaughn



Thomas James Gaughn was born 15 May 1890 in Ireland. He registered for the draft on 5 June 1917 at South St. Paul, stating he was a citizen of Ireland and that he worked as a motor man for Twin Cities Transportation in St. Paul. He was single and lived at 141 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue South in South St. Paul.

During the War, he served with Battery B, 304<sup>th</sup> Field Artillery Regiment, 77<sup>th</sup> Division. This Division is credited with service in campaigns at Aisne-Marne, St. Mihiel, Meuse-Argonne, Champagne, and Lorraine. Gaughn was killed in action at Vancere, France on 7 September 1918 and is buried in Oisne-Aisne American Cemetery.

No record of his family has been found.
